THE CHURCH AS THE PROPHET OF GOD

1st Reading (Jeremiah 1: 4-5, 17-19)

Jeremiah was one of the greatest prophets God sent among his people. This reading tells of his call by God and of his commission as a prophet.

2nd Reading (1 Cor 12: 31-13:13)

This contains Paul's great hymn in praise of love. He says that for a follower of Christ love is by far the most important virtue of all.

Gospel (Luke 4: 21-30)

This tells how Jesus shared the fate of every true prophet: he was rejected by his own people.
